2.1 National Sickle Cell Anaemia Elimination Mission

Why in news?

• Recently The Prime Minister launched the National Sickle Cell Anaemia Elimination Mission in Shahdol, Madhya Pradesh.

Important information

- Launch venue: Shahdol, Madhya Pradesh.
- Distribution of about **3.57 crore Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana** (AB-PMJAY) cards in Madhya Pradesh.
- Honoured Rani Durgavati (500th Birth Anniversary) the ruling queen of Gondwana in the mid-16th century.
- Mission was announced in: the Union Budget 2023.
- Aim of the Mission: address the pressing health challenges posed by sickle cell disease, particularly among the tribal population.
- Target year to eliminate sickle cell Anaemia: 2047
- Coverage: implemented in 278 districts of 17 high-focus states viz.,
- (Gujarat, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, West Bengal, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Assam, Uttar Pradesh, Kerala, Bihar, and Uttarakhand.)
- 4 Main components of the Mission: Screening, Prevention, Treatment and Research.
- Mission targets: screening approximately 7.0 crore people under 40 years of age in the next 3 years (from the fiscal year 2023-24 to 2025-26)
- Launched training modules: for primary, secondary, and tertiary care including medical officers, staff nurses, and Community Health Officers, Auxiliary Nurse Midwives, and Accredited Social Health Activist workers.

Additional information

- Sickle Cell Anaemia: is a genetic disorder that affects the shape and function of red blood cells (RBCs), which carry oxygen to all parts of the body.
- According to a 2018 report by the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), about 1.2% of the Indian population has sickle cell trait (SCT), which means they carry one copy of the mutated gene that causes SCA.



2.2 National Water Mission

Why in News?

- Recently, National Water Mission (NWM), Bureau of Water Use Efficiency (BWUE) & Indian Plumbing Association (IPA) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).
- **MoU Objective:** to create Water Positive India by awareness creation & promotion of rain water harvesting structures, low flow fixtures & sanitary ware, treatment of grey & black water, water audit of built environment.
- The MoU envisages to achieve the Goal-4 of National Water Mission (increasing the water use efficiency by 20%.)
- Focus will be on circular economy of water including grey water use (5Rs: Reduce Recycle- Reuse-Replenish-Respect) in built environment.

2.5 Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act, 2013

Why in news?

• Recently the Union Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment, chaired the eighth meeting of the Central Monitoring Committee at Dr Ambedkar International Centre.

Important information

- enacted in: 2013, come into force in December, 2014
- Key features:
- Aim: **complete elimination of the manual scavenging** in its various manifestations and comprehensive rehabilitation of the identified manual scavengers.
- Nodal Ministry: Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment.
- "Swachhata Abhiyaan": mobile app to capture the data of insanitary latrines still existing and manual scavengers associated with them.
- Ministry initiated **two surveys of manual scavengers** in the **year 2013 and in the year 2018**.
- Assistance: One Time Cash Assistance of Rs. 40,000/-.
- The Act **bans the use of any individual for manually cleaning, carrying, disposing** of or otherwise handling in any manner, human excreta till its disposal.
- States are now responsible for identifying and rehabilitating manual scavengers.

- Additions in the NeSDA 2023 framework:
- **Portals coverage**: e-Government at the City level **by assessing City Portal** i.e., the official portal of respective **City/Urban Local Body** that provides a single window access to the information and links to the services being provided for the citizens and other stakeholders in the city.
- Focus Sectors and Mandatory Services Coverage: NeSDA 2023 proposes an expansion on focus sectors with an addition of Transport and Public Grievance.
- In NeSDA 2023, additional 5 mandatory services at State / UT level and 12 services at Central Ministry level would be evaluated.
- In NeSDA 2023, a total of 59 mandatory services are proposed to be assessed for every State & UT and 37 services to be assessed covering 21 Central Ministries/Departments.
- Assessment Parameters: three additional assessment parameters, viz., Open Government Data (OGD), E-Participation, and Leveraging Emerging Technologies.

- NeSDA is a **biennial study** that **assesses States**, **Union Territories (UTs**), and focus **Central Ministries on the effectiveness of e-Governance service delivery.**
- Under the aegis of: Department of Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances (DARPG) had constituted the National e-Governance Service Delivery Assessment (NeSDA) in 2019.

- PSUs target: to produce more than 1 MMT of Green Hydrogen by 2030
- Funding from various institutions:
- **The European Investment Bank (EIB**) would support for developing large scale Industry hub with a funding of 1 billion Euros.
- The **Asian Development Bank (ADB)** conveyed their intent to provide \$20-\$25 billion over five years to aid India's aspirations for green growth.
- **The World Bank** has approved \$1.5 Billion in Financing to Support India's Low-Carbon transition journey.

Additional information

- 42% of power generation capacity of India today is based on non-fossil-fuels.
- As per the International Energy Agency, the world demand for hydrogen is expected to grow by 600% by the year 2050.



- National Green Hydrogen Mission, The target to build capabilities to produce at least 5 Million Metric Tonnes (MMT) of Green Hydrogen per annum by 2030 (70% earmarked for exports and the remaining 30% for domestic consumption)
- Three types of projects, viz., grand challenge projects, mission mode projects and blue sky projects for hydrogen production; storage and transportation; and end use applications respectively.
- Highlighted the need to drive down the **cost of green hydrogen** from **\$4.5/kg to \$1/kg by 2030**.


• Recently four multilateral agencies have launched a priority research agenda to better advocate for increased research and investment in antimicrobial resistance (AMR).

 - Belarus set to become a full member of SCO charter by 2024.
- New Delhi Declaration adopted at SCO Summit.
 - The Government of India coined the New Delhi Declaration.
 - o Aim of the declaration: to fight against terrorism
 - The Declaration also proposes four other joint statements on de-radicalisation, sustainable lifestyle to tackle climate change, production of millets and digital transformation.
- Two thematic joint statements were released
 - $\circ\;$ cooperation in countering the radicalisation leading to separatism, extremism and terrorism.
 - \circ $\;$ cooperation in the field of digital transformation.

Key Information Shared

- For the first time, the SCO Millet Food Festival, Film Festival, SCO Surajkund Craft Mela, Think Tanks Conference, and International Conference on Shared Buddhist Heritage were organized.

3.2 HDFC-HDFC Bank Merger

Why in News?

- Recently, the boards of HDFC and HDFC Bank approved the merger between the two institutions.
 - HDFC was India's biggest mortgage lender.
 - HDFC Bank is India's largest private lender.
- The merger became effective from July 1, 2023.
- The merger has made HDFC Bank, the world's fourth-biggest bank by market value behind JPMorgan, Industrial and Commercial Bank of China Limited (ICBC) and Bank of America

About HDFC-HDFC Bank Merger

- It is the **biggest transaction in India's corporate history**.
- Deal Value: USD 40 billion; Market Capitalization of HDFC Bank post merger: Rs 14.73 trillion (nearly USD 180 billion).
- With the deal getting effective, HDFC Bank will be 100% owned by public shareholders, and existing shareholders of HDFC will own 41% of the bank.
