- Recently The Prime Minister launched the National Sickle Cell Anaemia Elimination Mission in Shahdol, Madhya Pradesh.

##### Important information

- Launch venue: **Shahdol, Madhya Pradesh.**
- Distribution of about **3.57 crore Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) cards** in Madhya Pradesh.
- Honoured **Rani Durgavati (500<sup>th</sup> Birth Anniversary)** the ruling **queen of Gondwana** in the mid-16th century.
- Mission was **announced in: the Union Budget 2023.**
- Aim of the Mission:** address the pressing health challenges **posed by sickle cell disease**, particularly among the **tribal population.**
- Target year to eliminate** sickle cell Anaemia: **2047**
- Coverage:** implemented in **278 districts of 17 high-focus states** viz., (Gujarat, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, West Bengal, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Assam, Uttar Pradesh, Kerala, Bihar, and Uttarakhand.)
- 4 Main components** of the Mission: **Screening, Prevention, Treatment and Research.**
- Mission targets: screening approximately 7.0 crore people** under **40 years of age in the next 3 years** (from the fiscal year **2023-24 to 2025-26**)
- Launched training modules:** for primary, secondary, and tertiary care including medical officers, staff nurses, and Community Health Officers, Auxiliary Nurse Midwives, and Accredited Social Health Activist workers.

##### Additional information

- Sickle Cell Anaemia:** is a **genetic disorder** that **affects the shape and function of red blood cells (RBCs)**, which **carry oxygen** to all parts of the body.
- According to a **2018 report by the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR)**, about **1.2% of the Indian population has sickle cell trait (SCT)**, which means they carry one copy of the mutated gene that causes SCA.

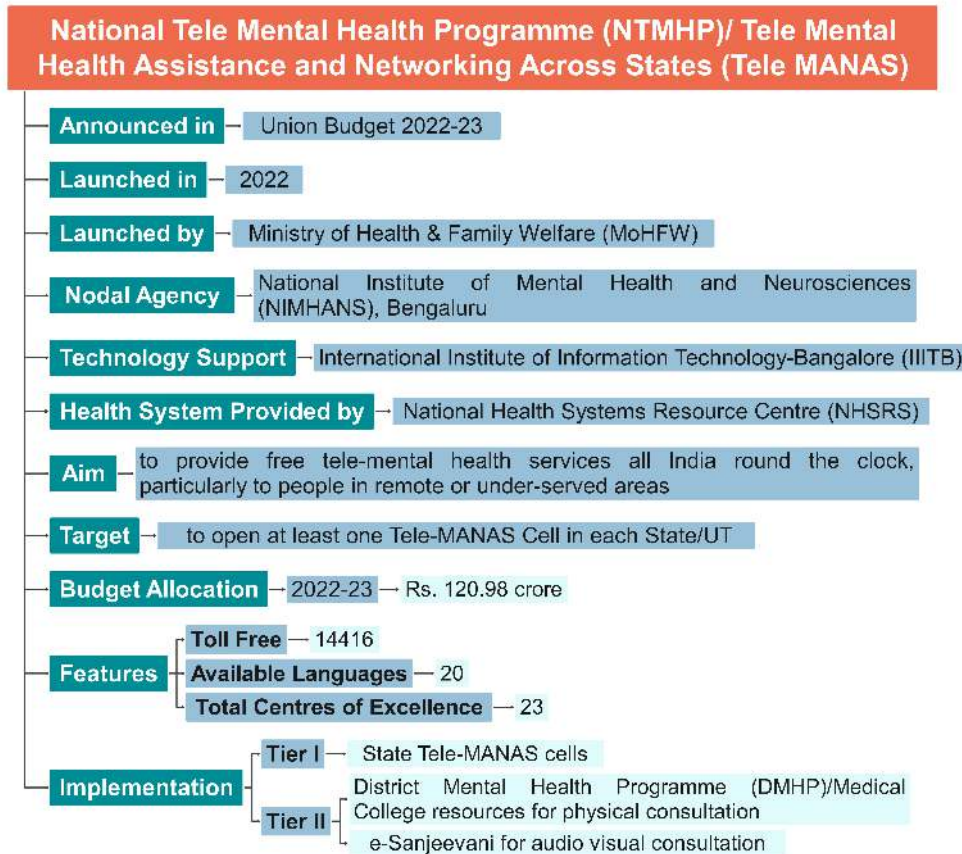

### Important information

- **US withdrawn** from UNESCO in: **2017.**
- **UNESCO: The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO)**
- Year of formation: **1945**
- HQ: **Paris, France.**
- Current membership: **193 countries.**
- **India is a founding member** of UNESCO. (UNESCO **office present in India since 1948**)
- **Nodal Ministry** in India which works with UNESCO: **Ministry of Education** (Erstwhile Human Resource development Ministry)
- **UNESCO World Heritage Site:** is a site **recognized by UNESCO** as having a **distinctive cultural or physical significance**, and which is considered of outstanding value to humanity.

## 2.19 FAO, UNEP, WHO & WOAHA launched One Health Priority Research Agenda for AMR

### Why in news?

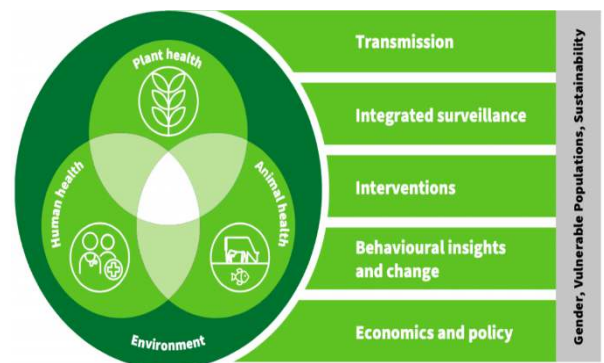
- Recently four multilateral agencies have launched a priority research agenda to better advocate for increased research and investment in antimicrobial resistance (AMR).

### Important information

- **Agencies involved: United Nations (UN)** Food and Agriculture Organization (**FAO**), the UN Environment Programme (**UNEP**), the World Health Organization (**WHO**) and the World Organisation for Animal Health (**WOAH**).
- **Purpose:** serve as a guide for countries, research institutes and funding bodies to support **One Health AMR research.**
- Fig: **One Health Priority Research Agenda on Antimicrobial Resistance.**

### Additional information

- **One Health:** it is an integrated, unifying approach that aims to sustainably balance and optimise the health of people, animals and ecosystems.
- **What is AMR (Antimicrobial Resistance)?**
- Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR) occurs when **bacteria, viruses, fungi and parasites change over time** and **no longer respond to medicines** making infections harder to treat and increasing the risk of disease spread, severe illness and death.



## 2.20 Global Crisis Response Group (GCRG)

### Why in news?

- Recently India has joined the Champions Group of the Global Crisis Response Group (GCRG).

### Important information

- **Established in:** March 2022.
- Nodal organization: **United Nations Secretary General (UNSG)**
- **Mandate:** to address urgent and critical global issues pertaining to interlinked crises in food security, energy, and finance and to coordinate a global response.
- **The GCRG is overseen by:** the Champions Group comprising of HOS/ HOGs of Bangladesh, Barbados, Denmark, Germany, Indonesia and Senegal.

## 2.21 Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO)

### Why in News?

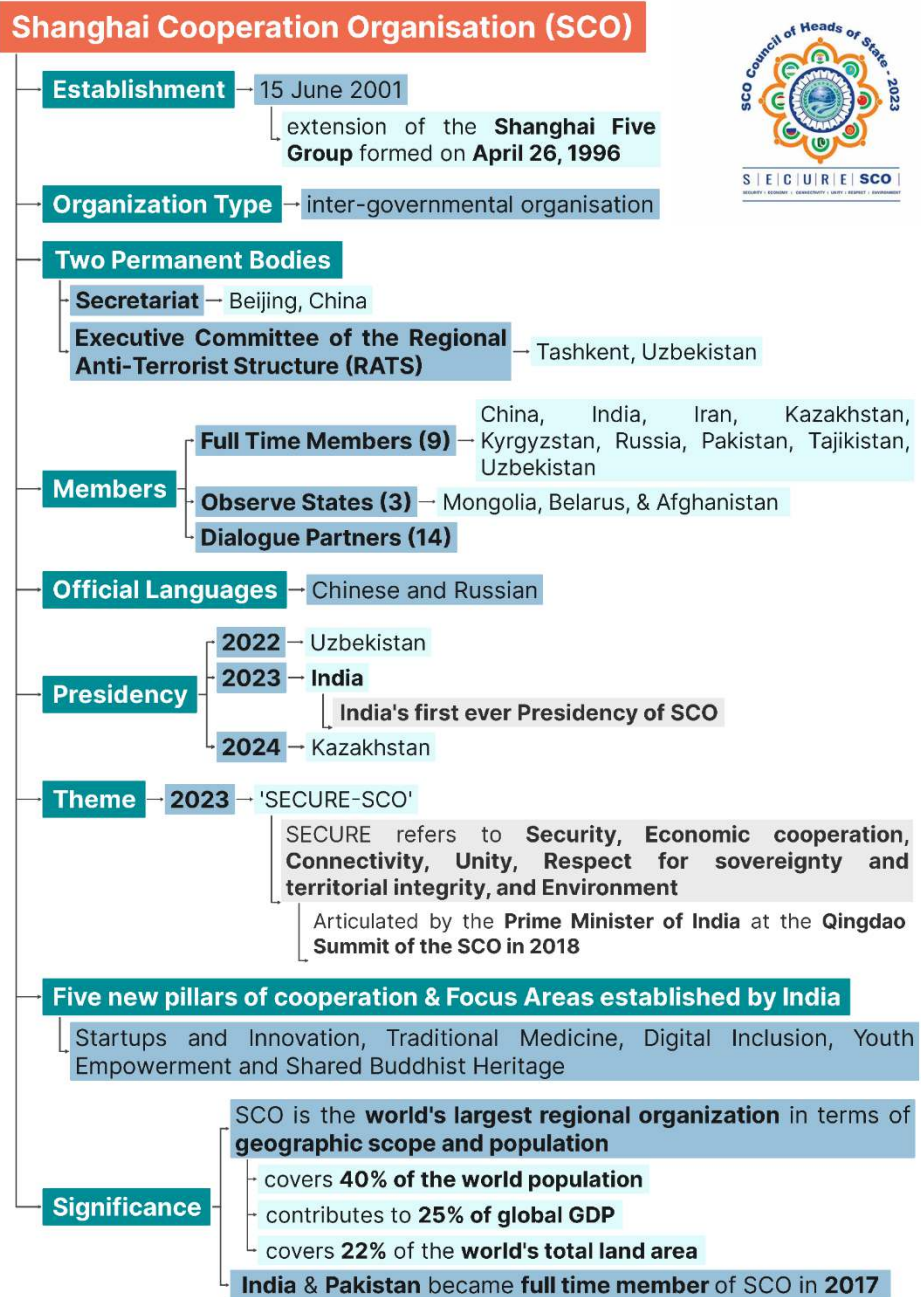
- Recently, the **SCO Summit 2023** (23rd Summit of the SCO Council of Heads of State), under **India's first-ever SCO Chairmanship** was **hosted virtually by India**.
- **Summit Chaired by:** Narendra Modi, Prime Minister of India
- **Summit Theme:** 'Towards a SECURE SCO'.

### Key Highlights

- **Iran** became the **9<sup>th</sup> member** of the **SCO**.
- **Memorandum of Obligation** for the **SCO membership** was signed by **Belarus**.
  - **Belarus** set to become a **full member of SCO charter** by **2024**.
- **New Delhi Declaration** adopted at **SCO Summit**.
  - The **Government of India** coined the **New Delhi Declaration**.
  - **Aim of the declaration:** to fight against terrorism
  - The Declaration also proposes **four other joint statements** on **de-radicalisation, sustainable lifestyle** to **tackle climate change, production of millets and digital transformation**.
- **Two thematic joint statements were released**
  - cooperation in countering the radicalisation leading to separatism, extremism and terrorism.
  - cooperation in the field of digital transformation.

### Key Information Shared

- **For the first time**, the **SCO Millet Food Festival, Film Festival, SCO Surajkund Craft Mela, Think Tanks Conference, and International Conference on Shared Buddhist Heritage** were organized.
- **Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh** has been declared as the **first tourism and cultural capital of the SCO**.

## RBI AND IT'S FUNCTIONS

### 3.1 Centralised Information Management System (CIMS)

#### Why in News?

- Recently, the **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has launched **Centralised Information Management System (CIMS)** during the **17th Statistics Day Conference** in **Mumbai**.
- It is the **latest next-generation data warehouse** of the RBI.
- **Commercial banks will first begin reporting on the CIMS**, followed by urban cooperative banks (**UCBs**) and non-banking financial companies (**NBFCs**).

### Additional Information

- **RBI** established its **first enterprise-wide data warehouse**, the **Central Database Management System (CDBMS)** in **2002**.

## RECENT DEVELOPMENT IN FINANCIAL SECTOR

### 3.2 HDFC-HDFC Bank Merger

#### Why in News?

- Recently, the **boards of HDFC and HDFC Bank** approved the merger between the two institutions.
  - HDFC was **India's biggest mortgage lender**.
  - HDFC Bank is **India's largest private lender**.
- The merger became **effective from July 1, 2023**.
- The merger has made **HDFC Bank, the world's fourth-biggest bank by market value** behind **JPMorgan**, Industrial and Commercial Bank of China Limited (**ICBC**) and **Bank of America**

#### About HDFC-HDFC Bank Merger

- It is the **biggest transaction in India's corporate history**.
- **Deal Value:** USD 40 billion; **Market Capitalization of HDFC Bank post merger:** Rs 14.73 trillion (nearly USD 180 billion).
- With the deal getting effective, **HDFC Bank will be 100% owned by public shareholders**, and **existing shareholders of HDFC will own 41% of the bank**.
